



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Sikkim Manipal Institute of Technology (SMIT) Sikkim Manipal University (SMU)

In order to promote cooperation and the advancement of academic and educational exchanges between College of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science, National Taipei University of Technology and Sikkim Manipal Institute of Technology, Sikkim Manipal University, the two institutions agree the following terms:

Within fields and terms that are mutually acceptable, the following general forms of cooperation will be pursued:

- Exchange of students
- Exchange of faculty, researchers, and staff
- Joint research activities
- Exchange of academic materials, publications, and information
- Special short-term academic programs

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this Agreement of Cooperation shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such agreements entered into, as outlined above, liaison officer to develop and coordinate the specific activities agreed upon.

This Agreement becomes effective on the date of signature. Unless an earlier termination is mutually agreed upon, it is valid for five years with the understanding that either party may terminate the Agreement with a notice given six months in advance. Revisions or modifications maybe proposed at any time, effective from the date of written agreement signed by both parties.
