

**AMENDMENT to
AGREEMENT ON DUAL DEGREE PROGRAM**

between

UNIVERSITY OF CINCINNATI

and

**NATIONAL TAIPEI UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY
(NTUT)**

THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into effective as of the ___ day of _____, 2017 by and between the University of Cincinnati College of Engineering & Applied Science (CEAS) and National Taipei University of Technology (TAIPEI TECH), collectively, the Parties.

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into an Agreement on Dual Degree Program dated July 20, 2016 (the "Articulation Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, Parties desire to amend the Agreement as set forth below.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants hereinafter set forth, it is mutually understood and agreed by the parties hereto, as follows:

The paragraph under Purpose shall be revised as follows:

1. This Agreement records the understanding between the University of Cincinnati College of Engineering & Applied Science (CEAS) and National Taipei University of Technology (TAIPEI TECH), collectively, the Parties, for the development and delivery of a collaborative (hereafter referred to as an "articulation agreement") program allowing for credit transfers between UC and TAIPEI TECH contributing to the award of the Master of Science (MS) degree from TAIPEI TECH and the Master of Engineering (MEng) degree from CEAS in engineering disciplines with matching curriculum.

The paragraph under The Parties shall be revised as follows:

- 1.2 National Taipei University of Technology (TAIPEI TECH) hereinafter referred to as TAIPEI TECH.

The paragraph under Objectives shall be revised as follows:

1. The first and second sentence in paragraph 2.1 shall be revised as follows:

2.1 The primary objective of this Articulation Agreement is to develop programs that benefit both TAIPEI TECH and CEAS. The Dual Award Master's Program will provide TAIPEI TECH students the opportunity to earn both a Master of Science degree from TAIPEI TECH and the Master of Engineering degree, at the University of Cincinnati CEAS in engineering areas with the matching curriculum.

2. The Paragraph 2.2 shall be revised as follows:

2.2 The Parties seek to establish a Dual Award Master's Program whereby students from TAIPEI TECH will be admitted to the graduate program both at TAIPEI TECH and in CEAS.

In accordance with paragraph 2.3 of the Agreement Parties agree to add additional engineering disciplines without creating a new Agreement. All references to National Taipei University of Technology (TAIPEI TECH) College of Mechanical and Electrical Engineering (CMEE) throughout the Agreement will apply to other participating colleges and departments of TAIPEI TECH.

All other terms and conditions contained in the Agreement remain unchanged.
